

Privacy Garden Fencing








Cequence Cedar post to be set out centres equal to the width of the fence panel to be installed.


When at the end of a fence run the panel should end on the outer edge of a post.



Install Cequence Cedar Posts into ground.

Screw Cequence panels into front face of post.


Intermediate panels are fixed midway to the front of the post. For end of a fence the panel should be fixed on the outer edge of a post.

Top of back batten up stand to be flush with top of post

Screw through the gap into the back batten and post





Position of post centres to be equal to the width of the fence panel to be installed.

Attaching the first panel side to the double sided post.








Intermediate panels are fixed midway to the front of the post. For end of a fence run the panel should be fixed on the outer edge of a post.







Attaching the capping rail.
